LOCATION

Yerba Buena Gardens is conveniently located in the cultural and retail heart of downtown San Francisco, adjacent to The Moscone Center, Market Street and all major public transit lines. The gardens occupy two square city blocks from Mission to Folsom streets and Third to Fourth streets.

SPECIAL EVENT FACILITIES

Yerba Buena Arts & Events (YBA&E) is a nonprofit organization that presents the annual Yerba Buena Gardens Festival of more than 100 cultural programs, presented free to the public. YBA&E also manages the rental of outdoor gardens venues for private receptions, parties and special events, as well as commercial video and photo shoots. Proceeds from rentals benefit free arts programming in the gardens. The experienced staff can assist in recommending caterers, tenting companies, performers, etc. to ensure a successful event. Esplanade (pictured): This lush, grassy five-and-a-half-acre expanse provides a tranquil setting for large-scale events. The Esplanade’s evergreen and deciduous trees, seasonal flora, cascading waterfall and built-in stone stage are complemented by the marvelous view of downtown San Francisco. The Esplanade can be tented and used for catering and food service.

Upper Terrace: The stone-surfaced Upper Terrace, located above the Martin Luther King, Jr. Waterfall, offers spectacular cityscape views from a crescent-shaped space adjacent to the lovely Sister Cities Garden and the calming Reflecting Pool.

East Garden: The pleasant East Garden, nestled in a grove of sycamore trees, sits opposite the breathtaking San Francisco Museum of Modern Art. The intimate bilevel space features a combination of grass and stone paving. The indoor YBCA Forum is also available as a combo package with the East Garden.

Rooftop Amphitheater: This multi-tier area combines grass and stone surface and is adjacent to the Zeum, the Yerba Buena Ice and Bowling Center and Children’s Play Circle. The amphitheater is an excellent choice for company parties with family activities.

Carousel Plaza: This plaza surrounding the historic 1906 Charles Loeffl Carousel can accommodate parties, special events and receptions. Carousel use can be included with this package.
